Process for Declaring a Surge in the PRC-Organ


The CSC Team Lead (TL) in conjunction with the PRC Manager or designate, identifies possible surge

All attempts to mediate the surge have been exhausted (i.e., attempted to call in extra staff when the number of active cases equals 3x number of PRC-Organ CSCs). PRC Manager (or designate) makes decision to trigger a surge response. The CSC TL in conjunction with the PRC Manager or designate will complete Section 1 of the Surge SBAR form to send to the PRC Manager or designate for review.

PRC Manager or Designate

Surge Determination Conference

PRC Manager (or designate) coordinates teleconference with PRC Team Lead, SOTDs, as required, Provincial Medical Director - Transplant, Provincial Medical Director - Donation Administrator On-Call, and Director Transplant Services (or designate) to discuss situation.



The participants of the Surge Determination Conference will review possible surge mitigation strategies and determine next steps collectively.

Targeted Communication

Provincial Medical Directors – Transplant and Donation, or designate, will facilitate targeted communication with affected transplant/donation hospital stakeholders to discuss the mitigation strategies that are required to manage the surge.

Follow-up Communication

The Manager (or designate) will be responsible for followup communication with affected donation/transplant stakeholders, and OH-TGLN staff until the surge event has been properly addressed and Surge concluded by the PRC Manager or designate.
